

## 2-01-2010 – West Deptford Band Parents General Membership Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 8:07 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Rose Rossiter gave the treasurers report.
  - If you would like to use your students' credits for trip payment, please fill out the form and give to Mr. Kershaw. He will give it to Rose.
- Winter Social – was a big hit. We have had a lot of comments and emails about it. It wasn't as profitable as we would have liked due to the snow but, everyone there had a good time.
- Reviewed the meeting minutes? Does anyone approve them? Jill Magill approved the minutes and Lilly seconded.
- Fundraising Report
  - Chick-Fil-A
    - We will have a West Deptford Band spirit night at the Chick-Fil-A in front of Lowes (on clement Bridge) on Monday March 8<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 pm to 8 pm. We will get 10% of all purchases from 5:30 pm until 8 pm. We need some students to help staff the event. The students will do things like: clean tables, greet customers, refill drinks, etc. Jill will check to see if we can put out a donation jar for people who just want to make a donation to the band.
    - Chick-Fil-A cheesecakes – we will start selling vouchers for the cheesecakes in February. The cheesecake vouchers are \$22. \$1 of the \$11 profit will go to the general fund. \$10 of the profit will go into student credits.
    - You have 6 months to redeem your cheesecake. They can only be redeemed at the Deptford Chick-Fil-A.
    - The Chick-Fil-A cow will visit us at Pops and Pasta to hand out flyers.
  - Jewelry
    - There will be a display of jewelry at Pops and Pasta. We are selling it early so we can get the jewelry in before Mother's Day. The Jewelry sale will end with a home demonstration – more details to follow.
  - Pops and Pasta
    - Pops and Pasta is on Saturday March 6<sup>th</sup>. We have no times yet. Please sign-up for a station to work at and to bring in something for all to eat.
    - Tickets for pops and pasta are \$8 for adults and \$6 for children.
    - We are thinking about using a hand stamp to make sure everyone pays before they eat. You will have to show your hand before you get spaghetti or desert. Everyone must pay for food except the students who will be performing. The hand stamp will help us know who hasn't paid.
    - Kids need to bring in a 12 pack of water or soda. Please only regular, diet and sprite/7up soda flavors.
    - We will have a basket auction during Pops and Pasta. If you have anything to donate, please let us know.
