E ach year the WDHS marching band packs up and heads south to Camp Ramblewood in Darlington, MD for their annual band camp. This year's band camp is scheduled from August 13-17. Band Camp is for all members/sections of the band including color guard, percussion, brass and woodwind sections.



This year's band camp cost will be \$310. This will cover all expenses (meals & lodging) for the five day stay. A deposit of \$160 will be due at the July

19th rehearsal with the balance due on the final day of Day Camp, Aug. 10th.

Band Camp is the single most important event in the band's calendar. The success of our group is closely related to group's achievement at camp. Routines, techniques, and procedures are developed and defined during these days. About 80% of our show will be taught at Band Camp.
