on May 29, 2024 and return on June 2, 2024.

Current estimates have the trip costing in the approximate range of \$1100-\$1200 for students and \$1500-1600 for adults for the 5 day trip. Mr. Kershaw and Mr. Wyatt along with the Band & Choir Parents Organizations are committed to keeping costs at a minimum as well as offering many opportunities to raise monies to offset out of pocket expenses.

This exciting opportunity is a large undertaking. The WDHS Music Department is always proud to take our students and display their talents for all to enjoy. This performance trip will allow the Band & Choir to represent WD & New Jersey in Music City—Nashville, TN!



Parent Groups Offer Much to the WDHS Music Department

The music department at WDHS owes a lot to our two parent organizations. Through their combined efforts, any opportunities are brought within reach of students due to both groups' activities and sponsored events.

The West Deptford Band Parents are heavily involved with support of the instrumental music activities at WDHS. Throughout the fall months, the band parents organize meals for the marching band, raise funds running the concessions during home varsity football games, sponsor and coordinate marching band competitions and help organize various fundraisers for students throughout the year.

Similarly, the West Deptford Choir Parents work to support the activities of the vocal music programs at WDHS. They organize events associated with the vocal program such as the biennial Madrigals Feaste and annual spring musical. They also coordinate many fundraising opportunities for music department students throughout the year.

All parents are invited to get involved and stay in the loop of all of their child's opportunities. Band Parents meet the first Monday of each month beginning in August at WDHS. The Choir Parents meet the second Tuesday of each month beginning in September at WDHS.



Vocal Music at WDHS

The WDHS Vocal Music Program offers a wide variety of singing opportunities. The Concert Choir is the central unit of the program and all singers perform with this ensemble. Madrigals meet daily as a class and students singing in this group must either audition or be recommended by their vocal music teacher. This select choir preforms at special events as well as concerts.

The Treble Makers is an extra circular SA chorus, featuring music made for close harmony treble voices.

The highlight of the vocal music year is the annual musical, when students are given an opportunity to rehearse and present a Broadway show. This always proves to be a great experience for all involved, and a wonderful opportunity to expand your horizons and perform on stage.

INSTRUMENTAL PROGRAMS & ENSEMBLES

Marching Band (July through December)

This group rehearses 2-3 evenings per week and performs 2-3 times per weekend.

Symphonic Concert Band (September through June)

This group meets daily as a class and performs throughout the year.

Jazz Lab (October through May)

This group rehearses 1-2 times per week after school and performs throughout the year.

Solo/Ensemble Performances (January through March)

Opportunities are given to students to prepare a solo performance to be performed at our annual March event.

VOCAL PROGRAMS & ENSEMBLES

Concert Choir (September through June)

This group meets daily as a class and performs throughout the year.

Madrigals (September through June)

This group meets daily as a class and performs throughout the year.

This group meets during evenings and performs in mid-March. Auditions are held in November.

Treblemakers/After School Vocal Ensemble (September through May)

This group rehearses after school once a week and includes trios, quintets and more.
